



Bobber Pumpkin Carving Stencils



Warning:

Bobber the Water Safety Dog reminds you that being safe is just as important out of the water as it is in it. Have a grownup help you with sharp cutting tools.

Tools:

Scissors, tape, fine-line marker, spoon, serrated knife or pumpkin saw from a pumpkin carving kit.

Instructions:

1. Cut a hole in the top for the lid large enough to insert your hand. Angle the cut inwards so your lid sits on top and won't fall through.
2. Scoop out the seeds and strings with a spoon.
3. Scrape some of the flesh from the inside so your pumpkin is about an inch thick all the way around (or at least wherever you'll be carving).
4. Trim along cutline in the corners of the stencil so it lies flat on the face of the pumpkin.
5. With a push pin, transfer the design by poking small holes along the design lines like a dot-to-dot.
6. Remove the stencil but keep it as a reference.
7. Use a fine-line marker to connect the dots on the pumpkin.
8. With a knife or pumpkin kit tool, carefully saw along the design lines, then gently push the pieces through with your fingers.
9. Place a candle or battery light inside your pumpkin and enjoy.

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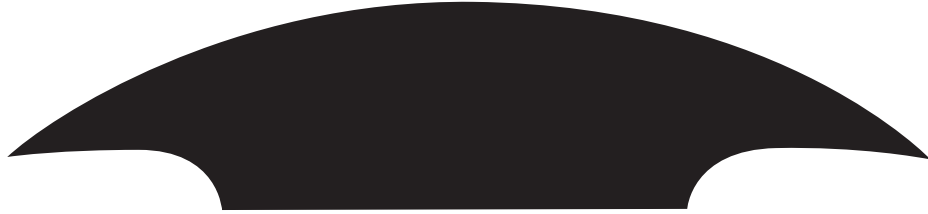
